SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1110, L. D. 1516, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Arrests for Motor Vehicle Violations."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 29, §2301, amended. The last sentence of
section 2301 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as
follows:

~~'The Secretary of State may suspend the registration of the motor
vehicle driven by such person when arrested, if said motor vehicle
is registered in this State by other than the operator of said
motor vehicle, provided he first gives 7 days' notice of his
intention to do so.'~~
