AN ACT Relating to Arrests for Motor Vehicle Violations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 2301, amended. The last sentence of section 2301 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

‘The Secretary of State may suspend the registration of the motor vehicle driven by such person when arrested **or summoned**, if said motor vehicle is registered in this State by other than the operator of said motor vehicle, provided he first gives 7 days’ notice of his intention to do so.’

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 2301, amended. Section 2301 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new sentence to read as follows :

‘The officer making the arrest or issuing the summons shall issue notice of such arrest or summons to the registered owner of such motor vehicle on a form approved by the Chief of the State Police, should the person arrested or summoned not be the registered owner according to certificate of registration.’
