SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1130, L. D. 1545, Bill, "An Act
for Licensing Private Detectives and Watch, Guard and Patrol
Agencies."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd underlined
paragraph of that part designated "§3804." and inserting in place
thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'The license of any person duly licensed as a private detective
on the effective date of this Act shall continue in force until the
expiration thereof, and shall be renewed upon payment of an annual
renewal fee of \$5 and a bond in the amount of \$500 and without filing
of the application referred to in section 3803.'
