HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 560,  
L.D. 1567, Bill, "An Act Relating to Definition of Licensee Under  
Liquor Law."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the beginning of the  
6th line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end the  
following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, §2, sub-§9, amended. The 4th  
sentence of subsection 9 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised  
Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Each such hotel shall be open for the convenience of the  
traveling public 7 days per week and a reasonable proportion of  
the gross income of each such hotel shall be derived from rental  
of rooms and sale of food; except that a reasonable proportion,  
~~but not less than 1/3~~; of the gross income of each hotel for which  
a part-time license has been issued shall be derived from rental  
of rooms and sale of food.' "
