SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 560, L. D. 1567, Bill, "An Act Relating to Definition of Licensee Under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Relating to Definition of Hotel Under Liquor Laws.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 28, §2, sub-§9, amended. The first sentence of subsection 9 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read af follows:

' "Hotel" shall mean any reputable place operated by responsible persons of good reputation, where the public, for a consideration, obtains sleeping accommodations and meals under one roof and which has a public dining room or rooms <u>either</u> operated by the same management <u>or by a lessee</u> open and serving food during the morning, afternoon and evening, and a kitchen, apart from the public dining food room or rooms, in which/is regularly prepared for the public on the same premises.' "
