SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1144, L. D. 1568, Bill, "An Act
Authorizing Qualified Licenses After Conviction for Drunken
Driving if Essential to Livelihood."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined
sentence of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
following:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the Secretary of
State may, after first convictions only, and after the expiration
of 6 months from the date of revocation, issue a restricted license."
