AN ACT Authorizing Qualified Licenses After Conviction for Drunken Driving if Essential to Livelihood.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1312, amended. Section 1312 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the Secretary of State may, after first convictions only, and upon payment of a fee of \$50 at the time of application, issue a restricted license. Such restricted license may be issued by the Secretary of State, after investigation, only in cases of extraordinary hardship and upon a clear showing by the applicant for such restricted license that revocation substantially and seriously impairs his means of earning a livelihood. A restricted license issued hereunder shall permit operation by such person of a specified vehicle within specified hours and provide for operation of the motor vehicle within prescribed geographical limits, and on specified days of the week.'
