STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Appeals by State on Questions of Law in Criminal Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 2115-A, additional. Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2115-A to read as follows:

‘§ 2115-A. Appeals by State on questions of law

Appeals from the rulings and decisions of any Judge of a District Court, a Justice of the Superior Court or a single Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court may be taken by the State to the Supreme Judicial Court on questions of law arising in a criminal case, with such limitations and in such manner as the Supreme Judicial Court may by rule provide.’
