HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1146, L.D. 1570, Bill, "An Act
to Revise the Workmen's Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 4 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 4. R. S., T. 39, §55, amended. Section 55 of
Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
'§55. Compensation for partial incapacity

While the incapacity for work resulting from the injury
is partial, the employer shall pay the injured employee a
weekly compensation equal to 2/3 the difference, due to said
injury, between his average weekly wages, earnings or salary
before the accident and the weekly wages, earnings or salary
which he is able to earn thereafter, but not more than \$42-a
week 2/3 of the average weekly wage in the State of Maine as
computed by the Employment Security Commission; and in no case
shall the period covered by such compensation be greater than
300 weeks from the date of the accident except for vocational
rehabilitation services provided under sections 52 and 54."
