HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1147, L.D. 1571, Bill, "An Act Revising
Certain Laws Under the Workmen's Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first sentence
of that part designated "§4." of section 1 and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'Section 3 shall not apply to employers who employ 5 3 or
less workmen or operatives regularly in the same business.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd
sentence of that part designated "§4." of section 1 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Said section shall not apply to actions to recover damages for
the injuries aforesaid, or for death resulting from such injuries,
sustained by employees engaged in domestic service or ~~in-agriculture~~
by seasonal or casual farm laborers.'
