AN ACT Relating to Appropriations for Certain Legislative Documents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Relating to appropriation for certain legislative documents. The words, "General Fund," in all bills, except appropriations for General Fund Bond retirement and interest, bills relating to state employees' pay (L. D. 239), uniform local effort for payment of school subsidies (L. D. 1041), current service appropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 1967 (L. D. 1354), supplemental appropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 1967 (L. D. 1524), and funds for accelerated program for the University of Maine (L. D. 1576), that appropriate money to finance the matters contained in the individual bills shall be construed to mean the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund.
