# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

#### AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Development of Swan Island.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Swan Island Game Management Area had over 1,200 visitors in the summer of 1965; and

Whereas, if the number of visitors continues to increase, it is vitally necessary that the following legislation be enacted for public safety and health and for the prevention of destruction of property through accidents or fires; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for development of Swan Island. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game the sum of \$25,000 for the purpose of matching federal funds for construction of capital improvements on Swan Island, Sagadahoc County. Such appropriation shall be a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967 and shall not be available until matching federal funds are available for the same purposes.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
