**AN ACT Relating to Inspection Station Licenses and Inspection Mechanic's
Certificates.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. Section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding after the 6th paragraph, 2 new paragraphs, as follows:

'The Chief of the State Police is authorized to make necessary rules and regulations for qualification for and retention of an inspection mechanic's certificate.

After hearing, as provided in Title 5, chapters 301 to 307, the Administrative Hearing Commissioner may suspend or revoke a current inspection mechanic's certificate issued by the Chief of the State Police and the privilege to obtain another inspection mechanic's certificate.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'After hearing, as provided in Title 5, chapters 301 to 307, the Administrative Hearing Commissioner may suspend or revoke the current license issued to any official inspection station and the privilege to obtain another official inspection station's license.'
