COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 619, L.D. 1612, Bill,
"An Act Increasing the Membership of the Industrial Accident
Commission."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof
the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
the General Fund to the Industrial Accident Commission the
sum of \$2,430 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and
the sum of \$12,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967
to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall
be as follows:
