Senate Amendment "A" to S. P. 635, L. D. 1616, Bill, "An Act to Prevent the Loss of Educational Subsidy in Certain Towns for the Year 1967."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following sections:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, §225, sub-§3, A, amended. The 2nd paragraph of paragraph A of subsection 3 of section 225 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The following question is to be used where a new school is to be constructed:

"Shall the school directors of School Administrative District No. \_\_\_\_\_ be authorized to issue bonds or notes in the name of said district for capital outlay purposes in an amount not to exceed \$ \_\_\_\_\_ and be authorized to borrow funds for capital outlay purposes in anticipation of state aid for school construction not to exceed \$ \_\_\_\_\_, to construct a \_\_\_\_\_ to be located at \_\_\_\_\_  
(primary or secondary school) \_\_\_\_\_?

(specifically define lot where school is to be erected)

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, §304, amended. Section 304 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence the following sentences:

'The school directors of a School Administrative District may be authorized to borrow funds for capital outlay purposes in anticipation of state aid for school construction purposes. Such authorization may be granted by the voters, voting upon an appropriate article under section 225, and any money so borrowed shall not be considered a part of the 12 1/2% debt limitation of the district.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 3.'
