

STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd. LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 606, L.D. 1619, Bill, "An Act Providing Convenience and Advantage for Loan Companies and Small Loan Agencies."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency Preamble. Whereas, Act of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, applications for loan companies and small loan companies have increased to such extent that some control is necessary to protect the interests and welfare of the people of Maine; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to prevent hardship and possible injustice to the many people who use the services of loan companies and small loan companies; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore.'

Further amend said Bill in the 13th line of section 1 (the llth line of section 1 of L.D. 1619) by inserting before the underlined word "convenience" the underlined word 'public'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
