AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Audit of District Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 243, sub-§ 4-A, additional. Section 243 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4-A, to read as follows:

'4-A. Audit for District Court. To install a uniform accounting system and perform a postaudit for the District Court, the expenses of such audit to be paid as follows: 50% by the District Court from the District Court Fund, 30% by the State Highway Department and 20% by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.'
