COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 610, L.D. 1624,
Bill, "An Act Appropriating Moneys for the
Continuing Activities of the Committee on Aging."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first
paragraph after the enacting clause and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated to the
Committee on Aging from the General Fund the sum of
\$2,000, the above amount being in addition to the
appropriation provided by chapter 199 of the private
and special laws of 1965. The expenditure breakdown
shall be as follows:
