**AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Members of Police Department of the City  
of Bangor.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1905, c. 349, § 1, amended.** The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 349 of the private and special laws of 1905, as amended by chapter 5 of the private and special laws of 1949, is further amended to read as follows:

'A pension is hereby provided for, to be paid by the City of Bangor to the following members of the police department of said city, said pension to be equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the **currently effective** pay ~~which such members received at the time of their retirement:~~
