AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Improvements at Houlton Airport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966, for such improvements at Houlton Airport as may be recommended by the Aeronautics Commission and approved by the Governor and Council. The expenditure shall be under the supervision of the Aeronautics Commission. This appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
