STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

AN ACT Relating to Automobile Graveyards and Junkyards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2451-B, amended. Section 2451-B of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 285 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

'§ 2451-B. Definitions

1. Automobile graveyard. "Automobile graveyard" as used in this subchapter shall mean a yard or field used as a place of storage in which there is displayed to the public view for 3 or more unserviceable, discarded, worn-out or junked automobiles or bodies or engines thereof.

2. Junkyard. "Junkyard" as used in this subchapter shall mean a yard or field used as a place of storage in which there is displayed to the public view for old, discarded, worn-out or junked plumbing and heating supplies and appliances, including but not limited to stoves and refrigerators, or old, discarded or junked lumber."
