

STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 658, L. F. 1641, Bill. "An Act Relating to Futies of Reporter of Fecisions."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following emergency preamble:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is essential that agreements with the publishers be completed as soon as possible to speed the Maine Reports and advance sheets to the legal profession; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to protect the interests of the inhabitants of the State in their guest for justice and equality under the law; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
