**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Administration of Bureau of Public
Administration at University of Maine.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Maine Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 102nd Legislature in regular session by legislative order directed the Bureau of Public Administration at the University of Maine in Orono to study the property tax administration and the desirability of anti-shack legislation; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that the following legislation be enacted to provide the bureau with the necessary funds to carry out the directives of the Legislature; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to be paid to the treasurer of the University of Maine to carry out the duties of the Bureau of Public Administration. Any unexpended balances shall remain a continuing carrying account and shall not lapse until June 30, 1969. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
