COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1186, L. D. 1654, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Power of Squirrel Island Village Corporation
to Erect Municipal Buildings."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, additional buildings and structures are needed for
municipal purposes of Squirrel Island Village Corporation to
render more efficient service to the inhabitants of the island; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that the following legislation
be enacted to permit the inhabitants of the island to appropriate
the necessary funds at the corporation's next meeting; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
