IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Providing Funds for Municipal Building at Old Orchard Beach.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1965, c. 189, amended. Chapter 189 of the private and special laws of 1965 is amended to read as follows:

Funds. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of ~~\$100,000~~ \$500,000 to the Town of Old Orchard Beach, to aid in the construction of a municipal building, including an auditorium. Such appropriation shall not be available until a like amount has been realized from voluntary subscriptions or land equivalent in value provided by the Town of Old Orchard Beach.

Sec. 2. Legislative intent. It is the intent of this Act to increase the previous appropriation of \$100,000 by an additional \$400,000.
