**AN ACT Making Appropriations for Salary Increases for Certain Employees
of the Department of Education.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves passed by the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the present act will become due and payable as of January 1, 1966; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriations for salary increases for certain employees of the Department of Education. In order to provide for salary increases for certain employees of the Department of Education for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1966 and June 30, 1967 the following sums or as much thereof as shall severally be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulations, are appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated. Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor and Council based upon work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall authorize expenditures of these appropriations and revenues accruing thereto.

Sec. 2. Effective date of salary increases. The salary increases as set forth in section 1 shall be retroactive to January 1, 1966.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
