RESOLVE, to Reimburse Arthur E. Thompson of New Gloucester for Fire Loss.

Arthur E. Thompson; reimbursement. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$9,523.39 to Arthur E. Thompson for loss of property destroyed by fire started by patient at Pineland Hospital and Training Center.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The barn of Arthur E. Thompson of New Gloucester, Maine, was destroyed by fire on November 22, 1964. The fire was set by an inmate of Pineland Hospital and Training Center. The inmate was sent to the reformatory at South Windham as a result of the crime.
