**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Match Federal Funds Provided Under Public  
Law 89-304 for Conservation and Development of Anadromous Fish.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game the sum of \$100,000 to match federal funds under Public Law 89-304 for the conservation, development and enhancement of anadromous fish, and for other purposes. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.
