**AN ACT Relating to Erection of Causeways, Docks, etc., in Great Ponds.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 514, sub-§ 3, ¶ C, additional.** Subsection 3 of section 514 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 13 of chapter 226 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding a new paragraph C, to read as follows:

**'C. Permits for the erection and maintenance of causeways, bridges, docks, piers, ramps, marinas, other structures or fill in great ponds, provided that prior to the granting of any permit an opportunity for hearing shall be given to any person claiming to be aggrieved should such permit be granted, and provided that the commissioner has first consulted with and had the approval of the Mining Bureau, the Water Improvement Commission, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game and the State Park and Recreation Commission.'**
