STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT ** to S. P. 675, L. D. 1713, Bill, "An Act for Licensing Private Detectives and Watch, Guard and Patrol Agencies."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§3808" by striking out in the 5th line from the end (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "100"

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, a new section, as follows:

'Sec. 2. Limitation. It is the intent of the Legislature that all private detectives appointed under Title 32, chapter 55, as it existed prior to the effective date of this Act and whose terms have not expired on the effective date of this Act shall be permitted to fill out their unexpired terms.'
