COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 677, L.D. 1715, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Outdoor Advertising."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of
paragraph B of subsection 3 of that part designated "§2762-A"
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'B. Primary system. Advertising signs, advertising
structures or devices:

(1) In areas adjacent to segments of the primary
system which traverse commercial or industrial
areas legally zoned as such by incorporated
municipalities, or

(2) In unzoned commercial or industrial areas
as may be determined by agreement between the
Secretary of Commerce and the State of Maine.

All such signs shall conform to the size, lighting
and spacing provisions consistent with the customary
use as determined by said agreement and the standards
provided for in section 2763.'
