COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 678, L.D. 1716,  
Bill "An Act to Provide for the Reconstruction or  
Enlargement of the International Bridge at Calais,  
Known as the Milltown Bridge."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting  
clause, the following:

'Emergency Preamble.Whereas, Acts of the Legislature  
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment  
unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Milltown Bridge at Calais is in need  
of reconstruction or enlargement; and

Whereas, an agreement with proper Canadian  
authorities to reconstruct or enlarge said bridge will  
be completed shortly; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary  
to prevent undue hazards and dangers to the travelling  
public between Calais and New Brunswick and the work on  
said bridge should be commenced as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these  
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
Constitution of Maine, and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end  
thereof the following:

'EMERGENCY CLAUSE. In view of the emergency cited  
in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
