COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 679, L.D. 1717, Resolve,  
Authorizing Transfer of State Land to City of Augusta  
for Fire Station.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 4th  
paragraph (same in L.D. 1717) and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'Governor; authorized to transfer land to City of  
Augusta.

Resolved: That the Governor is authorized and directed  
to transfer a rectangular parcel of land owned by the State  
in Augusta on the westerly side of Hospital Street with  
a frontage of about 135 feet on Hospital Street and to  
a depth of about 300 feet south of the now existing  
State Police Barracks to the City of Augusta to be used for  
a municipal fire station. In the event the city at any  
time ceases to use said land for said purposes, said parcel  
shall revert to the State of Maine.'
