STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

AN ACT Relating to the Transportation of Disabled, Collision Damaged, Wrecked or Repossessed Highway Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 35, § 1560, sub-§ 1, ¶ K, additional. Subsection 1 of section 1560 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph K, to read as follows:
 - 'K. While engaged exclusively in the transportation of disabled, collision damaged, wrecked or repossessed highway motor vehicles from the place of collision or disability or repossession to the place of repair or other final disposal.'
