COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1230, L.D. 1725, Bill,

"An Act Relative to Issuance and Revocation of Boarding Home Licenses."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 38th line (31st and 32nd lines of L.D. 1725) the stricken out words and figures "designated-in-Title-5;-ehapters-301-to-307" and inserting in place thereof the words and figures 'designated in Title 5, chapters 301 to 307'; and by striking out in the 9th, 10th and 11th lines from the end (8th, 9th and 10th in L.D. 1725) the stricken out sentence "A-person-aggrieved-by-the-refusal-of the-department-to-issue-a-license-may-file-a-statement-or complaint-with-said-Administrative-Hearing-Gommissioner:" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'A person aggrieved by the refusal of the department to issue a license may file a statement or complaint with said Administrative Hearing Commissioner.'
