STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

AN ACT Relating to Refund of Gasoline Tax to Companies Furnishing Common Carrier Passenger Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 2909, amended. The first sentence of section 2909 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Any person, firm or corporation engaged in furnishing common carrier passenger service under a certificate issued by the Public Utilities Commission shall be reimbursed and repaid to the extent of 3/7 of the entire amount of such tax paid by him upon that proportion of the internal combustion engine fuel used in locally encouraged vehicles operated by him which his tax-exempt passenger fare revenue derived from such service bears to his total passenger fare revenue.'
