IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Additional Personnel in the Elections Division of the Office of Secretary of State.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, in recent years the Elections Division has been preparing special state elections over and above the normal work load; and

Whereas, the Elections Division has been utilizing seasonal or part-time workers on a continuous basis in the preparation of said elections; and

Whereas, it is advisable to have a person to work with the election supervisor and learn the complicated process involved in setting up a state-wide election; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Additional personnel for Elections Division, Office of Secretary of State; appropriation. There is authorized in the Elections Division, Office of Secretary of State, a position as follows and there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Elections Division, Office of Secretary of State, the sum of \$1,408

for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$3,484 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
