STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Implement the State Technical Services Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

University of Maine; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the University of Maine the sum of \$50,000 to provide for the implementation of the State Technical Services Act (P. L. 89-182). Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The University of Maine has been designated by Governor Reed as the appropriate state agency responsible for the implementation of the State Technical Services Act of 1965.

The State Technical Services Act of 1965 was adopted on September 14, 1965 as a means of promoting the commercial and economic growth by supporting state and interstate programs to place the findings of science usefully in the hands of American enterprise.

The purpose of this Act, embracing the findings of the Congress, was to provide for a wider diffusion and more effective application of science and technology in business, commerce and industry.
