STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for the "Edmund S. Muskie Regional Airport."

Regional airport; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund a sum not in excess of \$1,200,000 for a regional airport to service Augusta, Waterville and surrounding areas to be located at the site recommended in The Buckly Report, so called. The expenditure shall be under the supervision of the Aeronautics Commission, subject to the approval of the Governor and Council. Such expenditure as may be authorized by this resolve shall be contingent upon the fact that not more than 50% of the project cost shall be paid for by funds herein appropriated. It is the intent of the Legislature to so limit the use of state funds as to require that federal funds and other funds shall finance 50% of the cost of the project; and be it further

Resolved: That the moneys appropriated by the 102nd Legislature by section B of chapter 161 of the private and special laws of 1965 for the Augusta State Airport in the amount of \$791,000 be allocated and applied for the purposes of this resolve; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve are accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The complete project will cost approximately \$2,400,000 of which \$1,200,000 will be the United States Government's share and \$1,200,000 will be the State of Maine's share.
