**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Construct Bridge Across Molunkus Stream,
Macwahoc Plantation, Aroostook County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

State Highway Commission; authorized. The State Highway Commission is authorized to construct a free highway bridge across Molunkus Stream, Macwahoc Plantation, Aroostook County, on Route 2, to replace the present bridge.

The expenditure of any funds for such bridge and approaches thereto, and the location, planning and construction of the bridge shall be under the direction and supervision of the State Highway Commission.

The sum of \$250,000 is allocated from the General Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
