STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

AN ACT to Authorize the Department of Health and Welfare to Initiate a Food Stamp Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Health and Welfare; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$9,780 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$24,950 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for the purposes of initiating a limited food stamp program in cooperation with the Federal Department of Agriculture as follows:
