AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Construction of Airport at Madawaska.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Airport at Madawaska; appropriation for. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 for the construction of the Madawaska Municipal Airport, on such recommendation of the Aeronautics Commission as may be approved by the Governor and Council. The expenditure shall be under the supervision of the Aeronautics Commission. This appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
