SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1258, L. D. 1753, Bill, "An Act Relating to Weight Tolerances of Vehicles Loaded with Wood Chips."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'An Act Relating to Weight Tolerances of Commercial Vehicles.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 5th through 10th lines and the word "equipment" in the 11th line (lines 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of L.D. 1753) and inserting in place thereof the following: " ' The operation on the highways of any vehicle ~~loaded-entirely-with-firewood,-pulpwood,-logs-or-belts-or loaded-entirely-with-farm-produce-or-dump-trucks,-tractor-dump trucks-or-transit-mix-concrete-trucks-carrying-highway-construction materials-or-the-operation--on-the-highways-of-any-vehicle-loaded with-any-products-requiring-refrigeration,-whether-by-ice-or mechanical-equipment~~ registered as a Maine commercial vehicle "
