**AN ACT Relating to Time Limitation on Exempting Liquor Bottled or
Manufactured in Maine from Additional Taxes.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1965, c. 438, § 2, repealed. Section 2 of chapter 438 of the public laws of 1965 is repealed as follows:

~~'Sec. 2. Limitation. This Act shall remain in effect until June 30, 1966.'~~
