COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1262, L.D. 1757, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Appropriation to Adjust State Employees'
Pay."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund the sum of \$2,929,994 to effectuate as of the first
pay period in January, 1966 and to effectuate as of the first
pay period in July, 1966, a pay adjustment plan for state employees
to be incorporated into the official State Pay Plan, adopted by
the State Personnel Board. The above appropriated funds are for
both classified and unclassified positions in the General Fund.
Any balance at June 30, 1966, shall not lapse but shall carry
forward into the 1966-67 fiscal year to be used for the same
purpose. The breakdown of expenditures shall be as follows:
