IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Eye Care and Special Services Division,
Department of Health and Welfare.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, in order to aid more efficiently and fuller certain segments of our population, funds are requested for the Division of Eye Care and Special Services, Department of Health and Welfare; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Eye Care and Special Services Division, Department of Health and Welfare, the sum of \$20,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967. The breakdown shall be as follows:
