COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1266, L.D. 1761,  
Resolve, Appropriating Funds for Constructing a Day School  
for the Mentally Retarded in Northern Maine.

Amend said Resolve by striking out everything after the  
Title, except the Statement of Facts, and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'Appropriation. Resolved: There is appropriated from  
the General Fund to the Aroostook Association for Retarded  
Children, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of \$73,500. Said  
funds shall be used for the construction of a day school.  
Available federal matching funds shall be utilized. The  
breakdown of expenditure shall be as follows:

1965-66

AROOSTOOK ASSOCIATION FOR RETARDED  
CHILDREN

All Other \$73,500 ; and be it  
further

Resolves, 1965, c. 84, repealed. Resolved: That chapter  
84 of the resolves of 1965 is repealed. '
