HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1267, L. D. 1762, Bill, "An Act Relating to Employment of State Criminal Inspectors in the Office of Attorney General."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that section 1 shall place the present special investigators under the Personnel Law but their salary shall be not less than the salary paid to them as of the effective date of this Act plus any increases granted through legislative action at the First Special Session of the 102nd Legislature.'
