**AN ACT Relating to Employment of State Criminal Inspectors in the Office of
Attorney General.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 197, amended. Section 197 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 197. Clerks; office expenses

The Attorney General is authorized to employ in his office in addition to the officers named in section 196, **state criminal inspectors and** additional clerks as the business of his office may demand, whose appointment and compensation shall be subject to the Personnel Law. He may incur a reasonable expense for postage, printing, stationery and other office expenses.'

Sec. 2. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that section 1 shall in no way affect the tenure of the office of the present special investigators who shall receive a salary not less than the salary paid to them as of the effective date of this Act.
