SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 695, L.D. 1781, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec.84. P.L., 1965, c. 482, \$2, repealed; limitation. Section 2 of chapter 482 of the Public Laws of 1965, heretofore passed by this Legislature in special session, enacting section 1258-A of Title 15 and relating to voir dire examination of jurors is repealed and shall not be printed as part of the session laws.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections of the bill to read consecutively.
